The Conservative Coalition of Harris County (CCHC) is a PAC dedicated to promoting conservative candidates within Harris County. Our PAC consists of conservative volunteers who send out questionnaires to the candidates, create panels that interview the candidates, and then vote for the best conservative candidate in each race. Our PAC has 10 core principles that define our beliefs/principles to our volunteers and to the voting public. We believe our core values define us by what we believe in and stand for. Candidates are selected on the basis of these core beliefs.

Our panels vote by secret ballots (just like voters) on the best candidate for each race we cover. The percentage totals are shown on the right of each candidate's name. If a candidate receives 70% or more of the panel vote, then that candidate is endorsed by our PAC.

The Conservative Coalition of Harris County (CCHC) is internally funded and no funds of any type were solicited, accepted or used from any candidates, their families, their co-workers, their staff, or their campaigns. We are a grassroots organization that is based in traditional conservative values. Although small, we are constantly expanding our pool of panel members that are willing to serve in screening candidates and serving on future candidate panels.
