Houston, Texas — The Conservative Coalition of Harris County PAC announced their endorsements of local Harris County ISD races.

In the Houston ISD, we are pleased to announce endorsements for **Matias Kopinsky** for Position 1, **Caroline Walter** for Position 5, **Kendall Lee Baker** for Position 6, and **Bridget Butler Wade** for Position 7. All candidates earned over 70% of our panel vote during recent interviews done in January. A CCHC endorsement means that these candidates support strong conservative values and our panel has recognized them above their opponents in these races. In the position 9 race, Gerry Wayne Monroe received 67% of the panel vote, which is slightly below the endorsement threshold.

Our results should be similar to how conservative voters will vote on the candidates in each election. Our voting results allows each conservative voter to quickly narrow down the conservative candidates in each race. The voter can then visit our website to see the candidates' CCHC questionnaire answers so they can make a comparison between candidates.

CCHC PAC is basically self-funded and raises money from our panel members during election cycles. We are a group of unpaid volunteers and no funds of any type were solicited, accepted or used from any active political candidates, their families, their coworkers, their staff or their campaigns (unlike other groups in Harris county that have the reputation of accepting fees and donations from candidates).
