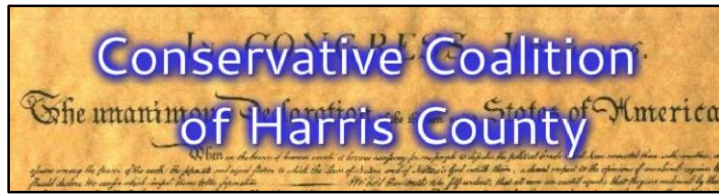

Houston, Texas — The Conservative Coalition of Harris County PAC announces their endorsements in non-partisan NW Harris County School District and Lone Star College Trustee races. Spring, Tomball and Klein School districts and Lone Star College have trustee positions that are scheduled for the November General Election this year. Only eight Trustee positions have contested races, in the Tomball, Klein and Lone Star College systems, otherwise the current incumbents were not contested in their re-election bids.
