

3. What are the most important issues that county republicans need to focus on to win local elections in Harris County in the November 2026 election?
- Answer:** I believe that the issues haven't really differed from what we have seen in the last 5 years. But we need to continue to focus and message on local issues that matter to the average independent voter – crime, economy, illegal immigration, flooding, government corruption, and housing affordability. We have planned and budgeted for 2 polls this year to identify these issues focused on 1) independents across the county (over 50% of the vote) and 2) the fastest growing demographic of the Latino voter – specifically in Commissioner Precinct 2. These will help us craft a targeted message to the voters.
4. What are your strategies to increase dissemination of Republican Party solutions to county issues and the Republican brand to the voting public?
- Answer:** The best strategy is to elect good conservative Republican candidates to elected office to implement good common-sense governance at the local level. That said through polling, creative messaging that targets voters, a comprehensive voter registration program, and aggressive grassroots and GOTV campaign – we have been and will continue to be effective in winning more elections. The way to disseminate the message will be done through the traditional means like mailers, robocalls, texting, radio and social media. But we will continue to use other creative means – podcasts, live streaming and holding our community conversations in non-Republican areas of Harris County.
5. Houston is scheduled to host the 2026 Texas State GOP Convention this year. What are your thoughts on increasing Harris County GOP party ideas and influence on the state GOP party and the grassroots to help turn out in the general election in November?
- Answer:** We have a comprehensive convention plan to aggressively market to our voters to increase attendance and involvement at the State Convention this year. We've had our Convention Committee working on preparing for our precinct and senate district conventions since last summer. We have a unique opportunity to increase our attendance and influence at the State GOP Convention since it is in Houston. In terms of influencing the RPT, relationships matter. Involvement matters – both at the state and the local level and during the convention. I am the only candidate in this race with the majority of the Harris County SREC members' endorsement in addition to the Texas National Committeeman's and Committeewoman's. I have a good relationship with the Chair and Vice-Chair of the RPT. Unity between HCRP and the RPT benefits not only Harris County, but Texas, too. I will work with anyone if they want to promote the values of the Republican Party and help conservative Republicans get elected to office.
