1. Please describe the qualifications and experience that make you the best candidate in your political race.

Answer: Before we begin, thank you for the endorsement in the 2020 primary. I sincerely appreciated that.

I've been in business for 30 years with experience in bridge construction, materials and heavy haul trucking, oilfield service, and international trade (construction equipment). I've been involved in the RPT for nearly two decades, been a delegate to State conventions for a number of years, authored two planks for the RPT platform, and helped make abolition of abortion a legislative priority.

I ran for U.S. Senate against John Cornyn in 2014 and 2020, garnering double digits in the primary. I am running for CD9 because I have more in common with the majority of this district than does any other candidate, and because I know more about this position – its authorities and limitations, and the mechanisms available to it to it – than does any other candidate as well.

2. Please explain what you believe are the most significant issues in this race, why you are running for this position and what differentiates you from the other candidate(s).

Answer: Ever increasing spending / perpetually rising debt and its negative impact on the value of the USD / illegal Immigration, immigration in general, and Work Visa abuse / foreign influence in government and requirements for holding office / rogue judges / corporate takeover if American farming

I am a Christian and a 6th generation Texan. I have been blessed with a wonderful wife of 35 years, and we have been blessed with three children and four grandchildren. I am also constitutional conservative, which means that I take the Constitution as written and amended.

My political views derive from a deep respect for the founding generations of both the United States and the Republic of Texas.

My conservative Texas-first values come from a family lineage that arrived in Texas while it was still Mexico and fought for Texas independence. I was raised with a Texas state of mind, which meant not relying on government, pulling yourself up by your bootstraps, helping your neighbor, and being charitable where your heart calls. This is the same state of mind so many of us share today.

My family history in the newly redrawn CD9 goes back over 125 years. Both my grandfather and father were born in Daisetta in Liberty County and both worked for Humble Oil. I was born in Baytown and lived in what was called the "Humble Camp" on the edge of Oak Edition where I attended Carver Jones Elementary. In the late 80s I took a job with Atlantic Richfield at the old Sinclair Refinery on 225 in Pasadena. While there I started Diamond K Equipment in 1996 and also moved to Liberty County. I saw the refinery change from ARCO to Lyondell to Lyondell-Citgo before leaving to run my company full time in January of 2002. I specialized in bridge construction, excavation, and trucking, but after the economic collapse of 2008 we were forced out of bridge construction in early 2012. I had already formed Liberty Testing in 2011, which was an oilfield service company, placing much of my focus on it.

I started trading construction equipment internationally in the 90s and have first-hand experience in monetary policy, tariffs, imports and exports. I've traded gear from Germany to Japan, Canada to Australia.

My wife and I have always been very involved in our community, particularly when it comes to kids and education. From sponsoring teams and organizations, to coaching and helping build fields and facilities, my wife and I have a long history of supporting our youth. My wife was a professional (SPED) educator who worked for La Porte ISD early in her career and retired from Tarkington ISD where I am currently a school board member and have been off and on since 2012. Over the years I have had the opportunity to speak in front of the State Board of Education as well as numerous legislative education committees.

I played almost every sport growing up and was a member of the FFA. I competed in rodeo (steer wrestling) in the early 90s and even bought my first competition horse trailer from my friend Larry Allen at his store off Red Bluff in Pasadena.

I began attending legislative sessions in 1999, and have been actively involved in the Republican Party of Texas since 2010. I've been a delegate to numerous State conventions



where I have worked with committees to support our conservative principles, and have personally authored two party planks for the RPT Platform, one protecting the rights of rural counties during an amendment to the State Constitution and one dealing with how to properly address overreach by federal judges.
