- Please describe the qualifications and experience that make you the best candidate in your political race.

I am a retired U.S. Army officer, small business owner, and lifelong conservative who has spent my career leading people, solving problems, and being accountable for results. I served during the Global War on Terror, where I learned the importance of decisive leadership, constitutional limits on government power, and putting mission and people first principles I will bring to Congress.

As a small business owner, I have created jobs, met payroll, navigated federal regulations, and dealt directly with the consequences of bad policy coming out of Washington. Unlike career politicians, I understand how taxes, inflation, and overregulation impact working families and employers in real time.

I have also been deeply involved in grassroots Republican politics, serving as a trained poll watcher and working closely with precinct chairs and conservative organizations across Harris County. I am not new to this fight, and I am not running to learn on the job.

My background in military leadership, business ownership, and grassroots activism uniquely positions me to represent Texas's 38th Congressional District with integrity, conservative principles, and the courage to stand up to the federal overreach that is hurting Texans.

2. Please explain what you believe are the most significant issues in this race, why you are running for this position and what differentiates you from the other candidate(s).

The most significant issues in this race are border security, national security, fiscal responsibility, and restoring constitutional limits on the federal government. The failure of Washington leadership has led to record illegal immigration, rising inflation, and growing global instability that directly impacts Texas families.

I am running for Congress because this district needs a representative who understands both the domestic and international consequences of weak leadership. As a retired U.S. Army officer who served during the Global War on Terror, I have firsthand experience with geopolitics, national security threats, and the cost of failed foreign and border policies. These are not abstract issues to me, they affect lives, sovereignty, and American strength.

What differentiates me from other candidates is my combination of military leadership, geopolitical experience, and small business ownership. I have operated in complex global environments, created jobs at home, and dealt directly with federal policy failures. I am running to bring disciplined leadership, America First principles, and real accountability to Congress.

3. What will your top 2 or 3 priorities be during this upcoming term?

My top priorities will be securing America's technological future, restoring fiscal responsibility, and protecting our nation from ideological threats that undermine freedom.

First, I will focus on what I refer to as the "Digital Dome" which is the convergence of artificial intelligence, quantum computing, robotics, cryptocurrency, and the energy infrastructure required to power them. These technologies will determine economic strength, military superiority, and individual liberty. Congress must ensure the United States leads in innovation while maintaining energy independence, grid resilience, and protection from foreign adversaries, particularly China.

Second, addressing the national debt is critical to our economic and national security. Runaway spending, unchecked deficits, and an expanding administrative state threaten future generations and weaken America's global standing. I will support serious spending restraint, accountability, and policies that restore fiscal discipline.

Third, I will work to halt the spread of radical Islam and any attempt to impose Sharia law in the United States. America is founded on the Constitution, individual liberty, and equal protection under the law. I will oppose any ideology, foreign or domestic, that seeks to undermine those principles or replace them with systems incompatible with American values.

4. **What are your solutions to identifying and cutting fraud and waste in the federal budget?**

Fraud and waste persist in the federal budget because Washington lacks accountability and consequences. My approach begins with transparency, enforcement, and structural reform.

First, Congress must require regular, independent audits of all federal agencies and programs, with automatic reviews and funding freezes for programs that cannot justify their spending or outcomes. If the Pentagon can be audited, every civilian agency can be as well.

Second, I support strengthening inspector generals and whistleblower protections, so fraud is identified quickly and reported without fear of retaliation. Oversight only works when those closest to the waste are empowered to expose it.

Third, Congress must eliminate duplicative programs, sunset ineffective agencies, and tie funding to measurable results. Programs that fail to meet clear objectives should not receive automatic reauthorization.

Finally, fraud and waste will not stop until lawmakers are willing to say no. I will oppose omnibus spending bills, demand line-item scrutiny, and support reforms that force Congress to live within constitutional limits and fiscal reality.

5. **What are the most important issues that Republicans need to focus on in order to maintain control of the US House in the November 2026 election?**

To keep control of the U.S. House in 2026, Republicans must stay focused on affordability, job creation, and security.

Affordability is the top concern for families facing higher prices for food, fuel, housing, and taxes. Republicans must rein in federal spending, unleash domestic energy production, and roll back regulations that drive up the cost of living.

Job growth comes from a strong private sector, not government expansion. Republicans should support small businesses, protect American workers, and encourage domestic manufacturing and innovation so wages rise and communities grow.

Border and national security are essential to economic stability and public safety. Republicans must secure the border, enforce immigration law, stop fentanyl trafficking, and rebuild military strength to deter foreign adversaries.

By delivering results on these core issues, Republicans can earn voters' trust and maintain control of the House.

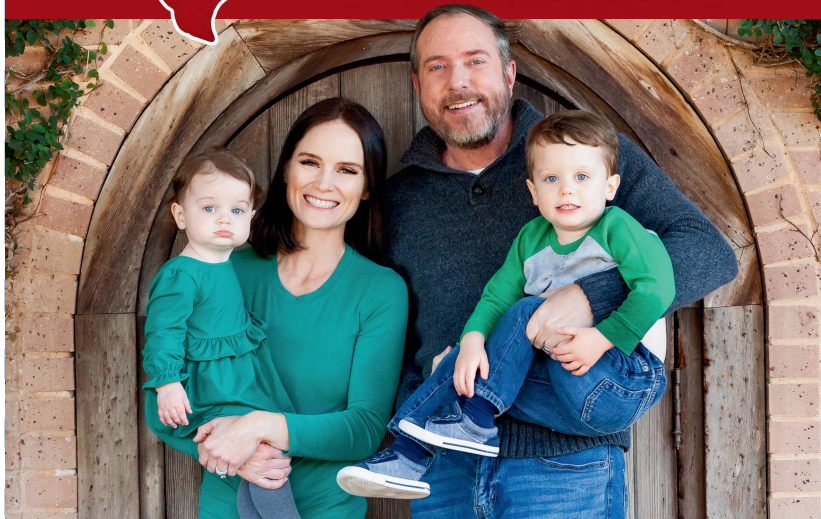

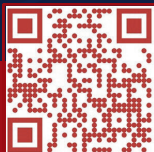
