- Please describe the qualifications and experience that make you the best candidate in your political race.

**Answer:** For 40 years I have resided in communities now served by the 38<sup>th</sup> US Congressional District. I have also committed my adult life and career to serving Texans. In the early 1980s, I patrolled the areas of Washington Avenue, River Oaks, and Memorial. Later, I served for years overseeing criminal investigations in the Houston Police Department. I have also served as the Manager of Texas TEA’s Safe and Supportive Schools Program supporting all local education agencies in Texas, including Cypress, Klein, Spring Branch, Katy, Tomball and Houston ISDs. On the education side, I have four graduate degrees, including a J.D., and master’s degrees in leadership, public service and administration, and business and economics. My five children attended and graduated from Cy-fair and Tomball ISD, other family members graduated from Katy ISD and some now attend work for Klein ISD. In short, this communities that fall withing CD38 are near and dear to me and an inextricable part of my life.

2. Please explain what you believe are the most significant issues in this race, why you are running for this position and what differentiates you from the other candidate(s).

**Answer: What differentiates me most from the other candidates as my public administration experience and the experience in government. Beyond the public safety experience, my experience includes Working with Texas And federal legislation experience since 1992 and legal experiences in 1995 as an attorney. Here below are the most significant issues in this race:**

### **Reviving the Economy & Reducing Inflation**

- Make housing more accessible; ease burdens on families facing rising living costs.
- Maintain the current federal tax cuts indefinitely.
- Cut excessive federal spending and regulations that hinder small businesses.
- Support expansion of energy production to lower fuel costs, increase jobs, and energy independence.

### **Protecting Texas Energy & American Energy Independence**

- Expand oil & gas production; roll back anti-energy regulations.
- Support infrastructure for pipelines, LNG exports, nuclear, and next-generation energy technologies — and encourage innovation (e.g. AI projects) in Texas.

### **Empowering Parents & Improving Education**

- Uphold parental rights in education; increase transparency in school curricula.
- Expand Career & Technical Education (CTE), support charter schools and school choice.
- Protect girls' sports and ensure fairness in school athletics.

### **Lower Taxes & Defending Property Owners**

- Cap property-appraisal increases; prevent skyrocketing property taxes.

### **Infrastructure, Flood Control & Growth Management**

- Expand major roadways to reduce congestion in rapidly growing Northwest Harris County suburbs.
- Secure federal support for flood control, improved drainage, and responsible development to protect neighborhoods.

### **Broken Health Care Under Obama Care (ACA):**

**In Congress, I would oppose indefinitely extending Obama Care to illegal aliens as that would ultimately make health care completely unaffordable for legal Americans. It is simply not sustainable. I will also work to lower healthcare costs by increasing transparency, boosting competition, expanding telehealth, and cutting the red tape that drives up prices for families and employers. I support strengthening HSAs, protecting seniors' Medicare, and investing in primary care and mental health so we catch problems early instead of paying more later in the ER.**
