1. Please describe the qualifications and experience that make you the best candidate in your political race.

Answer: I serve on the Texas State Board of Education for District 14, and this experience sets me apart from other candidates in that I see firsthand the impact of Texas educational priorities and how they influence the success, stability, and future of our state. With every vote, I upheld my Oath of Office in defending, preserving, and protecting the U.S. Constitution, and I also demonstrated that I work successfully with constituents to provide solutions to their problems.

2. Please explain what you believe are the most significant issues in this race, why you are running for this position and what differentiates you from the other candidate(s).

Answer: The most significant issues Texans face for a stable and bright future include restoring public education, enhancing public safety, ensuring affordability, stabilizing Texas' freshwater and energy sources, and protecting state sovereignty by upholding the U.S. and Texas State Constitutions.

I am running for this position to fix our public schools and prevent them from being privatized, which undermines our representative government and the principle of "consent of the governed." We must keep our schools community-controlled and free from global influence.

3. What will be your top 3 priorities with the state legislature during your upcoming term?

Answer: Education, public safety and affordability, water and energy crisis

Education:

I will champion legislation to restore Texas public education to traditional teaching, place hardback textbooks back into the hands of students, and limit students' device usage. I also will repeal Robin Hood recapture.

Public Safety:

I will initiate fraud prevention legislation that includes enhanced protections against exploitation and that holds leadership accountable for fraud and abuse. This legislation will provide transparency to the public on how the state administers federal funds and taxpayer programs.

I will ensure legislation restricting Artificial Superintelligence (ASI) expansion in Texas.

I will prioritize redesign of the property appraisal valuation process and oppose Central Bank Digital Currencies.

I will develop an emergency preparedness framework for cities and counties that provides a defined pathway for officials to access initial emergency aid with a rapid turnaround. This will include an effective emergency communication plan involving 911 services, estimates of aid for various natural disasters, and accountability measures for elected officials.

Water and Energy Protections:

I will put Texans first by approving legislation that safeguards rural communities and cities from IT Data center exploitation and that places restrictions on corporations and developers, ensuring they secure and pay for their independent freshwater and energy sources – not Texas taxpayers. We also must initiate noise control ordinances and environmental protections. I also intend to access and address the state's electric grid threats and vulnerabilities and place the necessary protections in place. Additionally, I will seek out other safe, cost-effective and reliable innovative energy sources to ensure public safety.

4. Should our Texas state government create an efficiency team (DOGE) that will use computer technology such as AI to expose fraud and waste within government agencies?

Answer: Our Texas state government can and should create an auditing team to expose fraud, criminal activity, and the effectiveness of taxpayer-funded programs. However, this efficiency team should not trample Texans' privacy via AI data mining.

5. What strategies do you have to increase deportation efforts in Texas in accordance with the current federal government ICE efforts?

Answer: Texas can further enhance cooperation and communication with local and county law enforcement to remove criminal elements quickly and safely. Due to our close proximity to Mexico, Texas can also partner with the U.S. federal government to enhance self-deportation of those whose country of origin is Mexico.
