Please give your answer to each of the following questions and please include your rationale with each answer. Please be concise and clear.

- Please describe the qualifications and experience that make you the best candidate in your political race.

Answer: I am the most qualified and experienced leader for House District 126 because:

I've devoted my professional career to engineering and community service, working to secure a better future for our children and grandchildren. I have a B.S. in Electronics Engineering from Oklahoma State University and have worked in the aerospace industry, the Central Test Facility for the International Space Station, and managing technical teams at Compaq Computer in desktop and laptop product development. Paul Bettencourt, when he was the Harris County Tax Assessor / Voter Registrar hired me as the Associate Director of IT Hardware, 3 ½ years before being elected Harris County Clerk.

I have lived in the district for over 30 years, and I have served as Republican Precinct Chair for PCT 0451, as President of the Conservative Cherry Tree Republicans for three terms, and as the elected Harris County Clerk and Chief Election Official. For over two and a half years, I have volunteered as the Harris County Republican Party Vice Chair for Election Integrity and Chairman of the Ballot Security Committee, devoting countless hours working with legislators and collaborating with election integrity leaders at the state and national levels.

I have been involved as a Republican activist and delegate since 1988 and have been a delegate at every Republican State Convention since. I have also served as an RNC National Delegate for the last six national conventions and was a member of the 2000 Electoral College as an Elector.

During my time in office and as Chair of the HCRP Ballot Security Committee, I worked with legislators on bills to make government work more efficiently and to improve the integrity of our elections, resulting in stronger safeguards and more transparent processes. I am a known and trusted resource for Republican legislators and will be effective from day one.

2. Please explain what you believe are the most significant issues in this race, why you are running for this position and what differentiates you from the other candidate(s).

Answer: The most significant issues for HD126 are:

- **Reduce Property Taxes & Insurance Costs**
- **Back the Blue & Protect Our Community**
- **Fight for Election Integrity in our Elections**
- **Infrastructure Solutions for Flood Mitigation**
- **Grow the Economy & Cut Government Waste**
- **Ensure Government Benefits Only Go to Citizens**
- **Stop Woke Policies and Defend Biological Truth**
- **Uphold our God-given Constitutional Freedoms**
- **Protect Life and Honor our Faith & Family Values**
- **Parental Rights & Excellence in Education**
- **Solutions for Artificial Intelligence's Impact on Texas**

I am running to ensure HD126 remains a strongly conservative Republican district for years to come. I have fought for decades as a Republican Precinct Chair, Republican club president, elected County Clerk, and Vice Chair of the Harris County Republican Party for Election Integrity, and I want to represent HD126's conservative Texas values in Austin.

Having served as Harris County Clerk and Chief Election Official, I have a proven record as a conservative, effective elected official. Voters in HD126 know my record and name, and many believe that recognition will translate into more votes in the general election than my opponents can draw in November, especially given the unique experience and knowledge I bring to the Texas Legislature on election integrity.

3. What will be your top 3 priorities during your upcoming term?

Answer: My top priorities for HD126 are:

- 1) SLASH PROPERTY TAXES – Property taxes are still too high, and this is the top issue in the district.**
- 2) PROTECT OUR CITIZENS – Reduce crime and ensure criminals are held accountable.**
- 3) ENSURE ELECTION INTEGRITY – I ran Harris County elections for eight years and currently serve as Vice Chair of the Harris County Republican Party for Election Integrity, making me one of the most experienced and knowledgeable legislators on election integrity in the Texas Legislature.**

Additional critical priorities:

- a. CONTROL FLOODING – Our community still expresses the need for long-term flooding control. Progress in funding has been made and projects are under construction, but citizens are still concerned.**
- b. CONTROLLING GOVERNMENT SPENDING AND STOPPING FRAUD - Our Texas voters see the fraud in Minnesota and want to ensure we root out all fraud in Texas. To significantly lower property taxes, we must stop fraud and cut wasteful government spending.**

4. What key public state issues do you think need to be addressed by Republicans in 2026-2027, such as AI data centers impact on electricity rates, fraud in state government social programs, DEI, medical rights, infrastructure, etc.?

Answer:

The list is long. Many of the issues are in my priorities above. Some additional issues are:

Remove incentives for illegal immigration, secure our border, and stop sanctuary cities from ignoring the law. The age of robotics will reduce the demand for unlawful labor, making it even more important that we uphold the rule of law.

Texas and the United States must plan now for the job losses that will be driven by AI, robotics, and self-driving vehicles. In line with RPT priorities, we must stop sexualizing Texas' children.

Vaccine choice laws were passed last session, but more must be done to strengthen protections so that parental decisions have real enforceable authority. Standing strong for life remains vital for Republican voters, and pro-life laws must be enforced and strengthened.

AI data centers are an issue, but their impact on electricity rates can be controlled by requiring them to install battery systems that charge at night and discharge during peak hours. Electricity rates are driven by peak demand on the grid, and Tesla has a second large-scale energy storage factory starting production soon in Katy, Texas, to build even more Megapack systems for deployment across the country.

5. What is your strategy in working with the Texas Senate to get more of the Texas GOP legislative priorities passed in the next legislative session?

Answer:

I personally know many of the Texas Senators. Senator Paul Bettencourt and Rep. Dennis Paul, the uncontested Republican candidate in Senate District 11, have both endorsed me. I know and have worked with Senators Birdwell, Hughes, Hall, Paxton, Middleton, Huffman, Kolkhorst, and Campbell on key conservative bills.

Many of the other Senators know who I am from my service as Harris County Clerk. Relationships are very important in advancing legislation, and my long-standing work with these leaders uniquely qualifies me to make a significant impact in the Texas Legislature.


