4. Please describe what you believe is the proper role for the federal government in job creation and intervention in the economy. What budget items need to be cut (i.e. social programs) and what taxes and fees need to be increased?
- Answer:** We need a government that realizes it is up to them to balance the needs of our business community against the rights of our citizens. Our economy, while it looks great from a stock market perspective, is the worst it has ever been for our citizens – At this point, we need to support our citizens by finding a way to create jobs which will decrease the need for social programs, and we need to tax those who are sending our jobs to other countries and importing non-immigrant guest workers to take our jobs here at home.
5. Polls indicate that illegal immigration is a top campaign issue. What ideas do you have to address the public’s concern on this issue, such as funding the border wall, amnesty, defunding “Sanctuary Cities”, etc.?
- Answer:** We need a wall just like those living behind gated walls need a wall to keep the unwelcome out. Illegal is illegal and it needs to be handled by our courts using our existing laws. Sanctuary cities are violating the laws that they swore to uphold and protect, so those making those decisions need to be tried by our courts and if found guilty of violating our laws, sentenced and the sentence carried out.
6. What changes should be made to the Affordable Health Care Act (Obamacare), and in general, to the US healthcare system by the Federal government?
- Answer:** Why are people being forced to pay insurance which is really all that it does.

I am still working as a janitor at the VA while I read in the news that the Dept of Labor and other government agencies hire H-1B's instead of veterans like myself that could do the work.

- ❖ **America is being lied to:** Corporations tell Washington and the media that America doesn't have the intelligence, the skills or the talent required for jobs, while American workers with the skills and talent are being laid off in favor of cheaper labor from abroad
- ❖ **American workers** are systematically being laid off and **required to train their foreign replacements**
- ❖ **American workers are required to sign non-disclosure agreements** in order to get severance pay in return for training their foreign replacements
- ❖ **The displacement of American workers has persisted silently** over the past two decades with the greatest harm to women, minorities, and college graduates
- ❖ **Foreigners on F-1 student visas on OPT get FICA-tax-free jobs** making foreigners more attractive and cheaper to hire than American students
- ❖ **Americans workers are being fired for not being complicit** when foreign managers ask them to make a layoff list
- ❖ **More than 70% of Silicon Valley tech workers are foreign born**
- ❖ **Foreigners in the U.S. are directly lobbying Congress and lying about their resident status** to change our immigration laws: HR1044/S386 reduces diversity in immigration and will further hurt American workers

HR3564 – The Fairness for High-Skilled Americans Act

OPT has grown 400% -- now bigger than H1B

- ✪ OPT is a jobs program that allows foreign F-1 visa holders to get tax-free jobs
- ✪ OPT was NOT authorized by Congress
- ✪ OPT is not merit based; any F-1 visa holder is eligible for OPT
- ✪ OPT is unlimited in number; there are NO caps
- ✪ OPT is unlimited in scope: Any job/multiple jobs can be taken.
- ✪ Neither the employer nor the F-1 worker pay the 16% payroll taxes (Medicare, Social Security & Federal Unemployment Insurance). They each pocket savings of 8.25% of payroll.
- ✪ OPT costs American taxpayers **\$3 billion** each year
- ✪ OPT allows foreigners to maintain their F-1 visa status and work in the US indefinitely (12 months initial OPT period for any F-1 visa holder; 24-month extensions for each STEM degree earned.)
- ✪ Less than 50% of U.S. STEM grads are landing jobs in STEM
- ✪ Every U.S. company has a 16% financial incentive to hire OPTs
