1.	Please describe the qualifications and experience that make you the best candidate in your political race.
	<b>Answer:</b> I believe I am the best candidate due to my extensive background and experience. I grew up in a military household and followed my sister to West Point. After graduating, I served 8 years in the Army as an Apache helicopter pilot and did a single tour of duty in Iraq as well as two tours of duty in Saudi Arabia. 2.	Please explain what you believe are the most significant issues in this race, why you are running for this position and what differentiates you from the other candidate(s).
	<b>Answer:</b> The top three most important issues in this race, as well as in our country, are fixing our economy that Joe Biden has wrecked, securing our southern border and finishing President Trump's border wall, and ending Biden's war on oil and gas. 3. What will be your top 2 or 3 priorities during this upcoming term?

**Answer:** We should absolutely finish President Trump's wall along our southern border. Over 2 million illegal immigrants have entered our country over the past year, and its finally time we end this grave problem. If Joe Biden won't do it, then our great state of Texas must fulfill that duty.
